

WASTE DISPOSAL IN THE PORTS OF ROTTERDAM-RIJNSMOND

AS OF 1 JANUARY 2018

As of January 1st 2017 the height of the waste fee will be based on the Gross Tonnage of the ship. The fee is meant as a compensation for the disposal of ship generated wastes of Annex I (oily waste) and Annex V (domestic and plastic waste). The fee is collected by the Port of Rotterdam Authority concurrent with the port dues.

WASTE FEE

Ships will pay a fee which consists of a fixed fee of € 200 plus a fee of € 0,02 per GT with a maximum of € 800 (€ 200 + € 600). Environmentally friendly ships (using MDO or LNG) pay 50% of the fee, but in exchange waive the right for the reimbursement of Annex I shipwaste.

WASTE REIMBURSEMENT

The waste reimbursement is based on a fixed amount which every waste collector receives per disposal and a variable amount, which is dependent on the amount of waste disposed per m³.

Waste Reimbursement Annex I:

Fixed amount	€ 200.00
Variable amount	€ 25.00 / m ³

Waste Reimbursement Annex V:

Fixed amount	€ 200.00
Variable amount	€ 25.00 / m ³
Reimbursement small dangerous waste	€ 100.00

If the costs for collection, transportation, storage and treatment are more than the reimbursement, the waste collector will send an extra invoice to the ship's agent. The reimbursement must be visible on the invoice.
